At the outset of the meeting Shri P. K. Tiwari, IAS, Principal Secretary, Revenue & D. M., General Administration, & Secretariat Administration Department requested Shri K. K. Mittal, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary, Agriculture etc. Department to initiate the meeting. Accordingly Shri K. K. Mittal, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary, Agriculture etc. Department addressed the Hon'ble Chief Minister, other Hon'ble Ministers and distinguished participants and asserted that this is an annual exercise wherein all the senior officers interact with Deputy Commissioners and Superintendents of Police and believe that the meeting will discuss problems in thread bare and the outcome will be very fruitful. The DCs and SPs are expected to bring out their views and problems. Thereafter the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam addressed the conference with his valuable speech.

The Hon'ble C.M. urged upon the Deputy Commissioners and Superintendents of Police to work at the best of their abilities to make Assam a leading state in the country and this should be the basic responsibility. He emphasised on the programme of "SABKA SATH SABKA BIKASH" to address the poorest of the poor sections of the society for making a visible change in the country.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister stated that "NRC" and the issue of Illegal Immigrants are national issues and we are proud to prepare the NRC after 70 years of independence. Therefore the DC's and all employees should work dedicatedly to prepare an "error free" NRC by 2017.

The Hon'ble C.M. stressed on the creation of a corruption free society for which every citizen/employees/officers should be vigilant, conscious and work in a dedicated manner.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister Stated that all employees/officers should know that "Respect is not demanded, it is commanded". The DCs/SPs should visit the villages and interact with the Gaon Bura at the grassroot level, identify the poorest family in each village.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister urged for discussion with the senior citizens and collect information on the way of working of the present Govt. discuss the better functioning of Govt. schemes. Cattle smuggling should be looked upon seriously. He asked all the DCs and SPs to submit report on social and economical status of the Char areas by physically visiting them.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister also spoke on trans border terrorism and creation of a terrorism free state. He urged the DCs/SPs to develop Public Relation with the people and try to bring solutions at the district level.

Slogan for corruption free state "I will not give; I will not take".

I. NRC :

Action points for all Deputy Commissioners and Superintendents of Polices.

- 1.1 Sri Prateek Hajela, IAS, State Co-ordinator, NRC stressed on the need for increasing the rate of office verification in all districts.
- 1.2 Quality checks done by the DRCCR, CRCCR, LRCCR should continue and done in an extensive manner.
- 1.3 The land documents verified during NRC office verification should be thoroughly checked to prevent any scrupulous or duplicacy of records.
- 1.4 The DCs were directed to attend a separate training on NRC process on 30.9.2016 at the state NRC office.

II. LAW AND ORDER

Action points for all Superintendents of Police.

- 2.1. Sri Hemanta Narzary, IAS, Principal Secretary directed all the SPs to develop a defence mechanism for strengthening the intelligence gathering to prevent any law and order situation.
- 2.2. SPs should focus on crimes against women, child trafficking, kidnapping internet / cyber crimes for which they should work unitedly with the civil administration.
- 2.3. Conviction rates for all crimes are poor, so SPs were instructed to co-ordinate with the public prosecutor.
- 2.4. Smti. L. S. Changsan, IAS, Commissioner & Secretary instructed the SPs and DCs to gather knowledge about post draft NRC publication and any apprehension of untoward situation and also to go continuous clearing of illegal encroachments.
- 2.5. The SPs were instructed to maintain vigil on the S.T. status of six communities demand and anti S.T. status of six communities demand group.
- 2.6. SPs were also instructed for speedy registration and proper and timely investigation of cases as the Police Accountability Commission is taking serious note on non registration of FIR's.
- 2.7. SPs were instructed for continuous vigil in disturbed areas to check crime against women, crime against children, cyber crimes, etc.
- 2.8. Deputy Commissioners impressed upon all for holding of crime conference in all districts in a structured manner.

- 2.9. DCs should take necessary action for timely submission of post – mortem reports and MVI reports through medical and transport Department to expedite the pending accident cases.
- 2.10. DCs will be the DDO for Foreigners Tribunals.
- 2.11. DCs/SPs to check the lists of “D” Voters and update the new lists.
- 2.12. DCs should also mark “D” status against the voters on any referral cases to Foreigners Tribunal.
- 2.13. Sri Kula Saikia, IPS, ADGP instructed all the SPs to be vigilant on the re-governing of terrorist organisation and post N.R.C. Publication

III. SWACCH BHARAT MISSION (GRAMIN) :
