Suspension Order

No. SWD.259/2009/18.-Whereas, as per the report of the Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta vide Letter No. BPE. 28/2007/323, dated 04.03.2017 and the Addl. Director, Social Welfare, Assam vide Letter No. DSW(G)/Misc /2016/Pt./69, dated 13.10.2017, it has come to the notice of the Government that Smt. Daisy Hazarika, Probation Officer-cum-DCPO, Barpeta have been unauthorizedly absent from her duties since October, 2016 and stayed out of station without availing of any leave from competent authority and without any intimation either to the District Headquarters or the Government.

Whereas, it is reported that Smt. Daisy Hazarika in the capacity of Probation Officer-cum-DCPO, Barpeta had issued some cheques under CM Special Package (2015-2016) during the first part of 2016, but a total 0f 2641 nos. of cheques could not be encashed on want of certain corrections, revalidations etc which could not be done within time due to regular absence from duty by Smt. Daisy Hazarika despite several communication in writing and over phone by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta.

Whereas, following such reports, the Government at Social Welfare Department had served Show Cause Notice to Smt. Daisy Hazarika, Probation Officer-cum-DCPO, Barpeta vide Letter No. SWD.259/2009/8, dated 20.04.2017 and SWD. 259/2009/19, dated 14.09.2017, but Smt. Daisy Hazarika did not consider it necessary to furnish any reply.

Therefore, it has become necessary to initiate action against the officer concerned.

Accordingly, pending drawal of Departmental Proceeding against Smt. Daisy Hazarika, Probation Officer-cum-DCPO, Barpeta, she is placed under suspension with immediate effect and until further order under provision of Rule 6 (a) of the Assam Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules. 1964 as amended.

During the period of her suspension, she will not leave headquarter without prior permission of the competent authority and she will be entitled to draw subsistence allowance as per rules.



- 2. Every notification and every other matter which is required to be printed and published in a particular issue of the Official Gazette must, therefore, reach the Deputy Director, Assam Government Press on the Monday of the week preceding the week in which it is required to be published. If this is not done it is infrictuous requesting the Deputy Director, Assam Government Press to publish such notification or other matter in the next issue of the Gazette, the expression usually inserted in all endorsements made to the Deputy Director.
- 3.
