#### **NOTIFICATION**

The 29th March, 2018

**No. FRE.183/2008/371.**- Whereas, the Government of India had accorded In-Principle approval for use of 10.583 Hectare of Borail Reserve Forest land in favour of National Highway and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL in short) for construction of four lanning of Balacherra-Harangajao section of NH-54 (Ext.) from KM 244.00 to KM 275.00 in the State of Assam vide their letter No. 3-AS C 014/2017-SHI/1942-43, dated 18-09-2017 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

Whereas, the NHIDCL in response has already complied with the conditions like payment of Net Present Value, transferring the cost of Compensatory Afforestation, payment of Overhead Cost, payment of felling operation cost of the trees falling within the proposed diversion area and cost of fixing the boundary pillars around the proposed diversion area which are among the most important conditions as laid down in the In-Principle approval letter.

Whereas, there are also other conditions, such as, demarcation of diversion area, by fixing boundary pillars and letter of undertaking etc. which are mandatory for obtaining final approval from Government of India, for allowing the NHIDCL to commence road construction work, and compliance of which are also stated as time consuming in the letter of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Head of Forest Force, Assam, No. FG.27-Nodal/Proposal/Road/Dima Hasao West Divn. Dated Guwahati, the 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2018.
