No. FSB.21/2015/293.-Consequent upon receipt of approval of the Central Government in the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food and Public Distribution, New Delhi vide No. 192(25)/2015-FC.A/Cs dated 13th October, 2016 read with Annexure appended therewith for payment of the provisional rates of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) Conforming to the uniform specifications as notified by the Government of Assam vide No.FSB.150/11/Pt/552 dtd. 01-09-2016 for Central Pool to the Government of Assam and its Procurement Agencies during the Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2016-17 and in exercise of the powers conferred under (h) of Clause 2 read with schedule III (paragraph B) of the Assam Paddy and Rice Procurement (Levy and Licensing) Permanent Order, 1995 read with the Assam Paddy and Rice Procurement (Levy and Licensing) Amendment Permanent Order, 2000, the Governor of Assam is pleased to fix and notify the provisional rates of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) together with breakup of approved admissible incidental costs of per quintal of such rice delivered to the Central Pool, during KMS-2016-17, as required under paragraph –B in Schedule III of the aforesaid Control Order and subject to the conditions as laid down and with immediate effect.

Custody and maintenance charges would be released on production of a certificate by the State Government that these charges have been incurred by it, subject to the partial amendment in Principle as per the order issued by Govt. of India vide letter no.192(4)/2003-FC A/Cs (Vol.III) dated 05-11-2015 and 12-11-2015.

\$ Commission to Societies is payable, Subject to the conditions laid down vide letter no 192(4)/2003-FC a/cs Vol-2 dated 26-07-2013.

** Gunny Depreciation is for procurement of paddy in new gunnies. Depreciation is being allowed as per the practiced followed by the state, subject to partial amendment in Principle as per the order issued by Govt. of India vide letter No. 192(3)/2014-FC A/Cs dated 18-12-2015.

I FCI should verify the provision on market fee from State Govt. notification before making actual payment.

Other Conditions

- The payment of commission to Societies will be subject to the conditions laid vide Ministry's order no. 192(4)/2003-FC A/cs (Vol II) dated 26.07.2013.
- In addition to the above, the following elements / items are also to be reimbursed to the State Government:
 - Guarantee Fee, if it is actually paid by the agencies to the State Government for obtaining credit, would be payable on actual basis, subject to a maximum of 1/8 % of MSP worked out on the estimated quantity of paddy delivered to FCI procured under Price Support Scheme (PSS) for the Central Pool. No interest on delayed payment on this account will be payable.
 - Transportation charges/Handling Charges for transportation of paddy from mandies / purchase centre to mills and for rice from mills to storage godown will be payable on the basis of the rates fixed by the District Magistrate of State or FCI's rate whichever is lower for beyond 8 Km for the actual distance.

3. Since milling charges are allowed @ Rs. 15 per qtl, for raw rice and @ Rs. 25 per qtl. For par boiled rice, transportation charges will be payable from 8 km onwards for transportation of paddy / rice from purchase center to mill and from mill to FCI godowns.
4. The Custom Milled Rice (CMR) would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in new 50 Kg bags only, in its local go-downs upto the scale point and the stacking in the FCI godown will be done by FCI.
5. The rate /cost of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) and other elements as indicated above are provisional. The State Government should send its claims for final incidentals along with accounts audited by the auditors appointed by the Comptroller and Auditor General and documentary proof, as well as detailed justification for each item at the earliest after the end of the season. The states who have not submitted finalization claims within four years of commencement of marketing season, only MSP, Statutory taxes, gunny charge will be given at prevailing rates. Other incidentals shall be frozen at the rates of PCS of previous years, ie 2015-16.
6. To ensure proper utilization of funds/subsidy being released by the Government of India, the FCI may insist on requisite certificates from the State Government and its agencies before release of incidentals on account of statutory charges i.e. Market Fee, RD Cess etc.
7. These rates / cost sheets are only for paddy / CMR procured by the State Agencies / FCI and not for any other party acting either on behalf of such State agency or the FCI. These rates would not be benchmarked to fix rate for such parties.
