Function of District Child Protection Committee (DCPC):

The DCPC shall coordinate and implement all Child rights and protection activities at district level. The specific function of the DCPC shall include:

- i) Contribute to effective implementation of Child Protection legislations, schemes and achievement of child protection goals laid out in the National Plan of Action for children 2005. In doing so, the DCPC will follow national and state priorities, rules and guidelines.
- ii) Ensure that for each child in need of care there is an individual care plan and that the plan is regularly reviewed. Monitor the implementation of the plan.
- iii) Identify families at risk and children in need of care and protection through effective networking and linkages with the ICDS functionaries, Specialized Adoption Agencies (SAA), NGOs dealing with child protection issues and local bodies, viz, PRIs and Urban Local Bodies, etc.
- iv) Asses the number of children in difficult circumstances and create district-specific databases to monitor trends and patterns of children in difficult circumstances;
- v) Map all child related service providers and services at district for creating a resource directory;
- vi) Identify and support credible voluntary organizations to implement programme components of the ICPS;
- vii) Support implementation of family based non-institutional services including sponsorship, foster care, adoption and after care;
- viii) Ensure effective implementation of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015 at district / city levels by supporting creation of adequate infrastructure, viz, setting up DCPU, JJB, CWC, SJPU in each district.
- ix) Ensure setting up of District, Block and Village level child Protection Committees for effective implementation of Programmes, as well as discharge of its functions;
- x) Facilitate transfer of Children at all levels for either restoration to their families or placing the child in long or short-term rehabilitation through sponsorship, kind ship care, in country adoption, foster care, inter-country adoption and placement in institutions;
- xi) Facilitate effective implementation of other legislations for child protection in the district, viz Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act (HAMA) 1956, Guardians and wards Act (GAWA) 1890; Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act 1986, Child Marriage and Restraint Act 1979 and Immoral Traffic Prevention Act 1986, Pre-conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act 1994 etc and any other Act that comes into force for protecting child rights;
- xii) Network and coordinate with all Government departments to build intersectional linkages on child Protection issues, including Department of Health Education, Social Welfare, Urban Basic Services, Backward Classes & Minorities, Youth Services, Police, Judiciary, Labour, State AIDS Control Society, among others;

- xiii) Network and coordinate with voluntary and civil society organizations working in the field of child rights and protection;
- xiv) Develop parameters and tools for effective monitoring and supervision of ICPS in the district;
- xv) Supervise and monitor all institutions / agencies providing residential facilities to children in district;
- xvi) Train and build capacity of all personnel (Government and Non-Government) working under child protection system to provide effective services to children;
- xvii) Encourage voluntary youth participation in child protection programmes at district, block and community level;
- xviii) Organize quarterly meeting with all stakeholders at district level including CHILD LINE, SAA, superintendents of homes, NGOs and member of public to review the progress and achievement of child protection activities;
- xix) Liaison with the SCPS, SARA and DCPCs of other districts;

SELF CERTIFICATION SCHEME

No. GLR. 71/2016/C/Pt/44. - As per DIPP recommendation under EODB, the Governor of Assam is pleased to formulate a self-certification scheme for the Factories established in the State in order to enhance participation and accountability on the part of the occupier so as to achieve comprehensive, systematic and trustworthy enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the Labour Laws administered by the Inspectorate of Factories.

The details of the aforesaid Scheme are as under:-

- 1. Introduction:** This Self Certification scheme is being introduced to stream line the functioning of the Inspectorate of Factories, Govt. of Assam for more effective implementation of various provisions under the different Labour Acts and Rules as administered by the Inspectorate.

This self-certification scheme also aims at making the occupier a conscious and truthful citizen and law abiding person who is willing to take care of the interests of the workers and employees by complying with all the laws as applicable under the scheme, and enable the Labour and Welfare Department, to effectively protect the interest of the workers as well as the occupier and create a friendly environment and relationship between the Administration and the occupier.

- 2. Objective:** The objective of this Self Certification Scheme is to facilitate hassle-free functioning of the factory and at the same time ensure complete statutory protection to the workers. The scheme is to streamline the requirements of inspection of specific industrial units, who opt for this scheme without compromising on the safety, health and welfare of the workers and allow to submit a self-certificate return in respect of compliances under the various provisions of Labour laws as administered by the Inspectorate of Factories.

3. Procedure: This Scheme shall be optional and any occupier can opt for this scheme after applying to the Chief Inspector of Factories, Govt. of Assam in the prescribed proforma in Annexure - I along with details as per Annexure - II and with a Self Declaration as prescribed in Annexure - III. Any discrepancy in the application or enclosures shall be communicated to the applicant within 30 days from the receipt of the application in the Office of the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam. In case, no discrepancy is so communicated, the applicant shall be deemed to have been enrolled under the above scheme.

4. Filing of Return: After being enrolled for the said scheme, the concerned occupier shall file the Self - Certification Return in the prescribed proforma given at Annexure - IV and Annexure IV - A along with the required documents and information. The return can be filled between 1st of January and 31st January every year on any working day during office hours.

5. Validity of Scheme: Factual information given in the prescribed Return shall be the same as on the date of filing the Return. The undertaking to abide by all the laws as applicable to the occupier shall be valid for a period of next one year.

Once opted for the Scheme, the same shall be valid for five years and the occupier shall file self-certificate return annually as prescribed. After the successful compliance under the Scheme for five years, the occupier shall have option either to remain covered under the scheme or opt out of the scheme. The option must be exercised in written to be made before the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam. In case the occupier successfully completes five years under the Scheme and during any inspection carried out, if no violations of law (s) is detected, the security so deposited shall be refunded. No interest shall be payable on the security deposited.

6. Amount of Security to be deposited: Any occupier who opts for the scheme shall deposit a security by way of Treasury Challan or online method as approved by the Govt. of Assam. At the opening of the scheme, the security amount shall be Rupees 20,000/- for the factories employing upto 100 workers, Rs 30,000/- for factories employing more than 100 and upto 250 workers and RS 50,000/- for factories employing more than 250 workers.

7. Forfeiture of Security Deposit: In case any occupier fails to follow the terms and conditions of the schemes or fails to file return in time under the scheme or fails to abide by any

undertakings given by him or any violation of law(s) is detected then security so deposited shall be forfeited and in the case of violation of laws, further necessary penal action as per the Act & Rule will be initiated and he will cease to continue under the Scheme. However, he can make fresh application for inclusion into the scheme subject to the discretion of the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam.

8. Labour Laws For which the Scheme is Valid: This Scheme is valid for following Acts and Rules made there under as applicable to the concerned occupier/employer:-

- a. The Factories Act, 1948 and the rules made there under as amended from time to time.
- b. The Payment of Wages Act, 1936 and the rules, made there under as amended from time to time.
- c. The Physically Handicapped Persons (Employment in Factories) Act, 1982 and rules made there under as amended from time to time.
- d. The Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulations) Amendment Act, 2016 and Rules there under.

9. Whom to Apply: Under the above scheme, the application for inclusion under the Scheme shall be made in triplicate as per Annexure I, addressed to the Chief Inspector of Factories Assam, with a copy to the concerned Inspector / Senior Inspector of Factories. Similarly the Self Certification Return (Annexure IV) duly filled and signed shall be sent in triplicate, to the Chief Inspector of Factories Assam, along with the relevant documents and a copy of the same shall also be sent to the Inspector of factories/senior inspector of factories concerned. The Self Certification Form in Annexure IV needs to be filed within the prescribed time limit as per the Scheme. The date shall mean the date on which the Application/Form is received in the Office of the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam.

NOTE: The Amount of Security deposited in the form of Treasury Challan, under the Head "0230 - Labour and Employment - 104 - Fees realized under the Factories Act"/online payment receipt shall be attached with the application (Annexure I).

10. Eligibility criteria: All Factories other than those carrying out Hazardous process, dangerous operations as defined under Factories Act and Rule & Major Accident Hazard installation as defined in Rule 2(g) of the Chemical Accidents, Rules, 1996 are eligible to opt for this self-certification scheme.

11. Inspection Procedure under the Scheme: Around 20 percent of the factories covered under the Scheme shall be picked up randomly for inspection in a year, which shall be carried out only once regarding the implementation of laws (Act and Rules) to which this Scheme applies. Once inspected, the same factory is not likely to be inspected in the entire period of five years of the scheme provided that no specific violation of terms, conditions, undertaking given under laws by the Occupier/Manager of the factory is brought to notice. However, on specific complaint, the Inspectorate of Factories, Govt. of Assam shall have full powers to inspect the factories covered under such scheme at any time and to take action against the erring management for the violation/offences etc.

A random inspection schedule for all such factories shall be prepared by the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam, and normally the inspection of those factories will take place in a year where specifically ordered by the Chief Inspector of Factories, Assam.

Factories which are not desiring to opt for the scheme will be inspected as the present system (computerized allocation).

Factory managements will have to obtain and renew the factory license whether the scheme of Self Certification is obtained or not.

The Copy of Scheme along with all prescribed application forms and inspection procedure shall be available with all the authorities in their offices and can be obtained at a price of Rs 100/-. Application shall be made in forms attached with the scheme as printed by the Chief Inspector of Factories, Bhangagarh, Assam.

12. The Government may at any time, modify or withdraw the notification.

Apparently, the above mentioned subject doesn't involve amendment in any related Rules, Acts.
