The members of the Governing Body of the Society shall hold office until a new Governing Body is appointed or present Governing Body is reconstituted by the Government of Assam.

The management of the affairs of the Society shall lie with the Governing Body.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

- (i) The meetings of the Governing Body shall be held at least once every year and at such time and place as the President shall decide. If President receives a requisition for calling a meeting signed by one-third members of the Governing Body, the President shall call such a meeting as soon as may be reasonably possible and at such place as he/she may deem fit. At least 15 days notice shall be given for holding such a meeting except in cases of emergency where three day notice may be given.
- (ii) At the annual meeting of the Governing Body the following business shall be placed and disposed of:
 - Audit Reports and Financial statements comprising of the receipt and payment account, income and expenditure account and the Balance Sheet for the past financial year.
 - Annual report of the Society.
 - Budget for the next financial year.
 - Annual Action Plan for the next financial year.
 - Other business placed with the permission of the President.
- (iii) Every notice calling meeting of the Governing Body shall state the date, time and place at which such meeting will be held. Such notice shall be under the hand of the Member Secretary and shall be accompanied by an agenda of the business to be placed before the meeting provided that accidental omission to give such notice to any member shall not invalidate any resolution passed at such meeting. In the event of any urgent business the President may call the meeting of the Governing Body.
- (iv) The President shall take the Chair at the meetings of the Governing Body. In his/her absence President may nominate one from among the members to preside the meeting.
- (v) One third of the members of the Governing Body shall form a quorum at every meeting of the Governing Body.
- (vi) All disputed questions if any at the meeting of the Governing Body shall be determined by votes. Each member of the Governing Body shall have one vote and in case of any equality of votes the President shall have a casting vote.
- (vii) Any business outside the agenda of the Governing Body meeting may be taken up on consent of one third members present in the meeting.
- (viii) Any member desirous of moving any resolution at a meeting of the Governing Body shall give notice thereof in writing to the Member Secretary of not less than seven clear days before the day of such meetings.

- (ix) In the event of any urgent business, the President of the Governing Body may take a decision on behalf of the Governing Body. Such a decision shall be reported to the Governing Body at its next meeting.
- (x) A copy of the minutes of the proceedings of each meeting shall be furnished to the members of the Governing Body as soon as possible after completion of the meeting.

POWERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

- (a) The Governing Body will have full control of the affairs of the Society and will have authority to exercise and perform all the powers, acts and deeds of the Society consistent with the aims and objects of the Society.
- (b) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of foregoing provision, the Governing Body may:
- Make, amend, or repeal any bye laws relating to administration and management of the affairs of the Society subject to the observance of the provisions contained in the Act.
 - Consider the annual budget and the annual action plan, its subsequent alterations placed before it by the Member Secretary from time to time and to pass it with such modifications as the Governing Body may think fit. Annual Budget shall be prepared as per budgetary allocation made by the State Govt. for the society for the relevant financial year and may include fund received from other sources as mentioned at para 6.1 of the Draft Rules.
 - Monitor the financial position of the Society in order to ensure smooth fund flow and to review annual audited accounts.
 - Accept donations, voluntary contribution, grants and endowments in cash or kind from public or other organisation or give grants upon such terms as it thinks fit.
 - Delegate its powers to Executive Committee or other authorities of the Society as it may deem fit to exercise their support to the Executive Committee constitute here in under.
 - Appoint committees, sub-committees and boards etc. for such purpose and on such terms as it may deem fit, and to dissolve / remove any of them.
 - To develop and adopt its own rules and regulations for recruitment and appointment of experts and administrative / technical staff and set its own compensation package for such experts / staff to be recruited from the open market and/or deputation basis. The compensation package for expert /staff shall be determined with prior approval of the Finance Department and all expenditure on this count including all other expenditure shall be limited to the annual grants received by the society from govt. in a particular financial year.
 - Develop and adopt procurement procedures for procurement of goods and services in line with the financial rules of the state.
 - Authorise the Member Secretary to execute such contracts on behalf of the Society as it may deem fit in the conduct of the business of the Society. All such contracts with financial involvement to be made from Govt. grants shall be placed before the Finance department for prior approval.
 - Do generally all such acts and things as may be necessary or incidental to carrying out the objectives of the Society, provided that nothing herein contained shall authorize the Governing Body to do any act or to pass any bye-laws which may be repugnant to the provisions hereof, to the powers hereby conferred on the Governing Body and other authorities, or which may be inconsistent with the objectives of the Society.

(c) POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE GOVERNING BODY

- The President shall have the powers to call for and preside over all meetings of the Governing Body.
- The President may himself/herself call, or by a requisition call, a meeting of the Governing Body at any time.
- The President shall enjoy such powers as may be delegated to him by the Governing Body.
- The President shall do all acts to achieve all aims and objective of the Society as incorporated in the Memorandum of Association of the Society.

- The President shall have the authority to review periodically the work and progress of the Society and to order inquiries into the affairs of the Society and to pass orders on the recommendations of the reviewing or inquiry Committee.
- Nothing in these Rules shall prevent the President from exercising any or all the powers of the Governing Body in case of emergencies in furtherance of the objects of the Society. However, the action taken by the President on such occasions shall be reported to the Governing Body subsequently.

The order comes into force with immediate effect.

SUBJECT :- Timely publication of Government Notifications and other important matters in the weekly Official Gazette.

I am directed to say that it has come to the notice of Government that important notification having bearing on statutes and matters of immediate public interest are sometimes published in the Official Gazette on date much later than prescribed. Government have decided, therefore, to introduce the following system with immediate effect, which must be strictly adhered to in sending notice to the Assam Government Press for publication in the official Gazette.

1. In the first instance, it has to be noted that the printing of the weekly Gazette must be completed by the end of every Tuesday so that it may be duly published on every Wednesday.

2. Every notification and every other matter which is required to be printed and published in a particular issue of the Official Gazette must, therefore, reach the Deputy Director, Assam Government Press on the Monday of the week preceding the week in which it is required to be published. If this is not done it is infructuous requesting the Deputy Director, Assam Government Press to publish such notification or other matter in the next issue of the Gazette, the expression usually inserted in all endorsements made to the Deputy Director.

3. Wherever it is necessary to print and publish a notification on a specified date (excluding such Notification or communicate as are to be published in Gazette extraordinary) clear instruction of that effect must be given to the Deputy Director, Assam Government Press, both on the body of such notification within the indication at the top in the red ink and is a separate covering.

4. To achieve the objective in papers 2 and 3, it is essential that proper discretion should be exercised by the concerned officers in the Department or office and all matters for publication in the Gazette should scrutinised and sent to the Press after careful application.
