NOTIFICATION

No. GLR.(RC)128/2015/20.- The following draft rules further to amend the Assam Factories Rules, 1950 hereinunder referred to as the principal Rules, which the Governor of Assam proposes to make in exercise of the power conferred by Section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948) is hereby published, as required under sub-section (1) of section 115 of the said Act, for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules will be taken into consideration after the expiry of the period of 45 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules before the expiry of the period specified will be considered by the Governor of Assam. Objections or suggestions, if any, should be addressed to the Secretary to the Government of Assam, Labour and Welfare Department, Dispur, Guwahati- 6.

Draft Rules

THE ASSAM FACTORIES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2016

Short title and Commencement	1.	(1) These rules may be called the Assam Factories (Amendment) Rules, 2016. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
Amendment of Schedule XVI	2.	In the principal Rules in Schedule XVI under rule 94 (inserted vide Notification No. GLR(RC)43/86/94, dtd. 02-02-1991, w.e.f. 19-02-1992), in clause 7, in sub-clause (5), after the last sentence the following sentence shall be inserted, namely :- “The person so discontinued from the said process shall be provided with alternate placement facilities unless he is fully incapacitated in the opinion of the Certifying Surgeon, in which case the person affected shall be suitably rehabilitated”.
