NOTIFICATION

No.GLR(RC)124/2017/29.- The following draft regulations further to amend the Assam trade Union Regulations, 1927 hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, which the Governor of Assam proposes to make in exercise of power conferred by Sec 29 of the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Act 16 of 1926) is hereby published, as required under section 30 of the said Act, for information of all persons likely to be effected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the said draft regulations will be taken into consideration after the expiry of the period not less than 60 (sixty) days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person/ persons with respect to the said draft regulations before the expiry of the specified period will be considered by the Governor of Assam. Such objections/ suggestions should be addressed to the Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam, Labour Welfare Department, Dispur, Guwahati- 6.

Draft Rules

The Assam Trade Union (Amendment) Regulation, 2018.

Short title extent and commencement.

1.

- (I) Theses regulations may be called the Assam Trade Union (Amendment) Regulations, 2018.
- (II) They shall apply to the whole of the State of Assam.
- (III) They shall come into force on the sate of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Insertation of regulation 20.

In the principal Regulations, after regulation 19, the following new regulation 20 shall be inserted, namely:-

"20 All Application for grant of registration under the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Act 16 of 1926), shall be disposed of by the Registrar of Trade Unions within a period of 45 (forty five) days from the date of receipt of such applications, provided the applications are complete in all respect.
