No. SEC. 24/2017/Pt-II/3.- The Assam State Election Commission, with respect to Rule 21 of the Assam Panchayat (Constitution) Rules, 1995 and in exercise of its authority under Article 243K of the *Constitution of India*, does hereby notify the list of symbols, as given below, to be used during the ensuing Panchayat Election, 2017-2018.

1. The following symbols shall be reserved for Recognised National and State Political Parties as indicated below against names of Political Parties:
