GOVERNMENT OF ASSAM ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR ASSAM ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

NOTIFICATION

Dated the 22nd November, 2017

AERC (PROCEDURE FOR FILING APPEAL BEFORE THE APPELLATE AUTHORITY) REGULATIONS, 2017

No. AERC 636/2017/44.— In exercise of powers conferred by Section 181(2)(zo) read with Section 127(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf and after previous publication, the Assam Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following Regulations providing for the procedure for filing appeal before the Appellate Authority, namely:-

1. Short title, commencement and interpretation –

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Assam Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procedure for filing Appeal before the Appellate Authority) Regulations, 2017.
- (2) These Regulations extend to the whole of the State of Assam.
- (3) These Regulations shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Assam Gazette.
- 2. **Definitions** In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (a) "Act" means the Electricity Act, 2003;
- (b) "Appellate Authority" means the authority notified by the State Government under Section 127 read with Section 176(2)(u) of the Act and Rules made thereunder;
- (c) "Assessing Officer" means the assessing officer designated under Section 126 of the Act;
- (d) "Commission" means the Assam Electricity Regulatory Commission;

(e) "Licensee" means a Distribution Licensee as defined under the Act.

Words and expressions used but not specifically defined herein but defined in the Act or the Rules / Regulations framed thereunder shall have the meaning assigned to them in the Act or the Rules / Regulations framed thereunder. The other expression used herein but not specifically defined in these Regulations or in the Act or the Rules / Regulations framed thereunder, but defined in any law passed by a competent legislature and applicable to the electricity industry in the State shall have the same meaning assigned to them in such law. Subject to the above, expressions used herein but not specifically defined in these Regulations or in the Act or the Rules / Regulations framed thereunder or in any other law passed by a competent legislature shall have the meaning as is generally assigned in the electricity industry.

3. Filing of appeal -

- (1) Any person aggrieved by a final order made by an Assessing Officer under Section 126 of the Act, may, within 30 days of the said order, file an appeal before the Appellate Authority.
- (2) The appeal shall be made in the form specified in the Schedule.
- (3) The Memorandum of Appeal shall be signed and verified in the manner specified in the Schedule.
- (4) The Memorandum of Appeal shall be accompanied by documentary evidence of deposit of a sum with the licensee equal to half of the assessed amount, as provided under section 127(2) of the Act.
- (5) The Memorandum of Appeal shall be accompanied by such fee as has been specified in the AERC (Payment of Fees, etc) Regulations, 2015 and its subsequent amendments.
- (6) The fee shall be paid in such form as the Appellate Authority may direct.
- **4.** As far as practicable, the Appellate Authority shall pass an order within 120 days from the date of the Appeal. The Appellate Authority shall record in writing the reason(s) for any delay beyond the specified period.

5. Reporting -

The licensee shall be required to furnish information to the Commission within one month from the end of every six months in a year regarding the status of disposal of appeals, in a manner, as specified in Appendix-A.

6. Miscellaneous -

- (1) Subject to the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission may, from time to time, issue orders and directions in regard to the implementation of these Regulations and procedures to be followed.
- (2) The Commission may, at any time, add, vary, alter, modify or amend any of the provisions of these Regulations.
- (3) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of these Regulations, the Commission may, by general or special order, do such thing not being inconsistent with the provisions of the Act, which appears to be necessary or expedient for the purpose of removing the difficulties.
