No. ECF 200418.- Whereas certain draft rules further to amend the Settlement Rules, Chapter 1, section 1 of the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, were published in the Assam Gazette Extra Ordinary No.537 dtd. 5th December, 2023 inviting objections or suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby before the expiry of a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of publication of said Notification in the Official Gazette.

And whereas no objections or suggestions were received within the said period from the public in respect of the said draft rules.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886, the Governor of Assam is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Settlement Rules under the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886, in the manner hereinafter appearing, namely:

| Short title and commencement | 1. (1) These rules may be called the Settlement (Amendment) Rules 2024.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. |
| Amendment of rule 26 | 2. In the principal rules, after rule 26, the following shall be inserted, namely:-
"26(A). If any settlement holder, transfers, any part or whole of his settled lands anytime after the date of settlement, such settlement |

holder including the spouse shall be ineligible for further settlement of Government land, notwithstanding any other provision contained in any other law, even if he becomes landless:

Provided that such ineligibility of the settlement holder shall not bar his successor from receiving any settlement of Government land in future."
