**No. FRE.43/2019/145.- Whereas**, a departmental proceeding was drawn up against Shri Borsing Bey, AFS (Retd.) the then Divisional Forests Officer, Doomdooma Division, Doomdooma and a show cause notice was issued vide Letter No. FRE.43/2019/78, dated 27th May, 2019 along with Statement of Allegation of charges, List of Exhibits, to Shri Borsing Bey in respect of the following charges:

1. Charge No.1 : Abject failure in discharge of assigned duties by gross misuse of vested power.
2. Charge No.2: Non compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's order and procedures framed in consonance with the directives of the Apex Court.
3. Charge No.3 : Suppression of material facts from superior authorities with ulterior motive.

The defence statement submitted by the delinquent officer has been received in the Department on 16-08- 2019.

**Whereas**, on being not satisfied with the defence statement submitted by the Delinquent Officer, the Environment & Forests Department instituted a Departmental enquiry by appointment of a Inquiry Officers vide Letter No. FRE.43/2019/106, dated 17<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2019 and Presenting officer vide Letter No. FRE.43/2019/106-A, dated 17<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2019.

**Whereas**, meanwhile Shri Borsing Bey, AFS, the then DFO, has superannuated on 30.11.2019. As such the D.O. has been intimated that the departmental proceedings initiated against him, upon his superannuation is maintainable under Rule 21 of the Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969.

**Whereas**, the enquiry officer, Shri S.P. Vashistha, IFS, Chief Conservator of Forest, Upper Assam Zone, Guwahati, has submitted his enquiry report and findings vide letter No.FET.221/Depttl.Proceeding /UAZ/2019/Pt, dated 21.11.2020.

Therefore, upon perusal of all charges framed, connected papers, documents etc. and hearing of the person concerned, the undersigned arrived upon conclusion which was very unambiguously stated in the enquiry report, reproduced as below-

1. Charge of abject failure in discharge of assigned duties by gross misuse of vested power is proved beyond doubt,
2. The charge of "Non compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's order and procedures framed in consonance with the directives of the Apex Court" is proved beyond doubt,
3. The charge of "Suppression of material facts from superior authorities with ulterior motive" is proved beyond doubt.

Therefore, the Governor of Assam in exercise of power conferred by the Rule 7 of the Assam Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1964 is pleased to conclude the proceeding drawn up against Shri Borsing Bey, AFS, (Retd.), the then Divisional Forests Officer, Doomdooma Division, Doomdooma, with a minor penalty of **Censure** under Rule 7(i) of the Assam Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1964.
