#### RESOLUTION

Pending amendment of the Rule 10(3)(b) Assam Economic and Statistics Service Rules 1973 framed under the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the State Government is pleased to make the following principle as regards the upper age limit for entry into various posts on Economic and Statistical Service, in the spirit of government policies pertaining to the upper age limit as spelt out in OM NO AAP 115/72/Pt-I/194 dated 10<sup>th</sup> March 2008 and OM No ABP 6/2016/9 dated Dispur the 25<sup>th</sup> April 2018 as the case may be. Considering the acute shortage of the base level staff engaged for assessment and evaluation of State resources, the necessity for filling up the core posts such as inspector of Statistics in the Transformation and Development Department was felt for a long time. Consequent upon this , it was decided by the Government in the Transformation and Development Department that the existing vacancies in the Inspector of Statistics in the Department shall be filled up by way of direct recruitment urgently. Accordingly, for recruitment of a total of 21 posts, proposal was moved to Assam Public Service Commission vide PDS 65/2011/Pt-III/124 Dated Dispur the 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2018.

Whereas the Commission on receipt of the proposal have made a query about the provision of 36 years of age as upper age limit for entry into the service as provided in the Rule of Assam Economic and Statistical Service rules 1973 which is a deviation from the existing government policy of 38 years.

The Government after careful consideration of the matter and keeping in mind the rule 10(3)(b) of the Assam Economic and Statistical Service Rules 1973" hereby orders that pending amendment of the rule 10(3)(B), concerning the upper age limit for entry into Statistical Inspector shall be inserted as below. "The candidate should not be more than 38 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the year in which the advertisement is issued: provided that the upper age limit in respect of candidates who have been serving in lower post of cadre in service and in the Assam Economic and Statistical (Junior) Service for a minimum period of five years on the date of application, shall be 40 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the year in which the advertisement is issued.

Provided that the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to five years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled castes and Scheduled tribes and up to such number of years in respect of the candidates belonging to the category of exservicemen, person with disabilities, women candidates and other backward /more other backward classes of candidates as may be fixed by Government Policy in force."
