Indrani Goswami, Deputy Director of Information and Public Relations, Barak Valley Region (now under suspension) was found absent from duty without obtaining prior permission of the competent authority and therefore serious mismanagement took place regarding media persons who came to cover the programme of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam. As a result a number of media persons got agitated and left the venue causing much embarrassment to the Govt.;

Whereas, the Government has considered this as a serious misconduct and gross negligence of duty on the part of Smti. Indrani Goswami for causing an embarrassing position to the Government;

Whereas, pending drawal of Departmental Proceeding, Smti. Indrani Goswami, Deputy Director of Information and Public Relations, Barak Valley Region was placed under suspension under Rule 6(1)(a) of the Assam Services (Disciplinary & Appeal) Rules, 1964 vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.88/2002/340 dated 15/06/2020;

Whereas, a show cause notice was issued to Smti. Indrani Goswami, Deputy Director of Information and Public Relations, Barak Valley Region (now under suspension) vide Govt. letter No.IPRD.23/2020/53 dated 26/08/2020 for her gross indiscipline, serious negligence of her official duties etc. to which she submitted her replies in defence vide letter dated 04/09/2020;

Whereas, Smti. Indrani Goswami submitted her written statement stating that she is suffering from some illness and has applied for commuted leave w.e.f. 14/04/2020 to 14/06/2020 on medical ground and requested to withdraw her suspension order.

Therefore, after careful examination, the Governor of Assam is pleased accept her reply and revoke the suspension order which was issued vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.88/2002/340 dated 15/06/2020 and also pleased to exonerate her from the charges levelled against her. Her period of absence w.e.f. 14/04/2020 to till date be treated as on leave as due and admissible to her.

Thus, the Departmental Proceeding drawn up against Smti. Indrani Goswami, Deputy Director of Information and Public Relations, Barak Valley Region is hereby disposed of.

No.IPRD.91/2012/pt/31.- Whereas, an advertisement relating to paying homage in memory of Swahid Birangana Kanaklata Barua on her death anniversary by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam, was published on 20th September, 2018, in a number of daily newspapers of Assam. But it appears that the advertisement should have carried also the name of Swahid Mukunda Kakati and a numbers of other Swahids who also sacrificed their lives for the country on the same day. But, due to total negligence on the part Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam, the newspapers carried the name of only Swahid Birangana Kanaklata Barua for which Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain had admitted his fault in his explanation letter and therefore Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain was warned not to indulge in such practices in near future and to be careful before releasing any advertisement in future, otherwise the Govt. will be compelled to take stern action against Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain;

Whereas, the Display Advertisement issued and published in a number of dailies on the occasion of Silpi Divas on 17th January,2019 to pay respect and tribute in memory of Rupkonwar Jyotiprasad Agarwala by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam, carried major errors. This had also occurred due to total negligence on the part of Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations. This had led to severe criticism in both the print and electronic media;

Whereas, the Government had considered this as a serious misconduct on the part of Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain by repeating the same practice even after he was warned not to indulge in such practices in near future vide Govt. letter No.IPRD.91/2012/39 Dtd.12/10/2018; and

Whereas, pending drawal of Departmental Proceeding, Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam was placed under suspension under Rule 6(1)(a) of the Assam Services (Disciplinary & Appeal) Rules,1964 vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.91/2012/58, dated.28.02.2019;

Whereas, a show cause notice was issued to Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.91/2012/67, dated.29.06.2019, for his gross indiscipline, serious negligence of his official duties etc. to which he submitted his replies in defence vide letter dated.03.07.2019;

Whereas, the written statement submitted by Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain in defence was not found satisfactory at all;

Whereas, Government decided to hold an Inquiry into the charges levelled against him by appointing Smti.Arundhati Chakraborty, ACS, Joint Secretary, now Addl. Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Information and Public Relations as Inquiry Officer vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.91/2012/pt/10, dated. 07.10.2020;

Whereas, subsequently, the order of suspension in respect of Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam was revoked and he was reinstated in his service vide Govt. Notification No.IPRD.91/2012/75, dated. 21.08.2019;

Whereas, the Inquiry Officer vide her letter No. IPRD.91/2012/pt/16, dated. 07.10.2020, submitted her Inquiry report to the Governemnt with the findings, where it appears that the charges levelled against him were clearly established;

And whereas, after careful consideration of the Inquiry report, the material on record and the submission made by Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain on the enquiry report and also keeping in view his past sincerity, unstinted cooperation towards achieving goals as well as dedication towards his works, it has been decided to accept the enquiry report and impose penalty of censure as per clause (i) under Rule 7 (3.3.2) of the Assam Services (Disciplinary & Appeal) Rules,1964.

Therefore, the Governor of Assam is pleased to accept the Inquiry report submitted by the Inquiry Officer and to impose the penalty of censure as per clause (i) under Rule 7 of the Assam Services (Disciplinary & Appeal) Rules,1964 upon Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam, with a direction not to repeat such acts in future. **For the period of suspension w.e.f. 28.02.2019 to 21.08.2019 he shall not be entitled for anything else except the subsistence allowance for the period of his suspension. However, the period of his suspension shall be counted towards pension purposes and other pensionary benefits.**

Thus, the Departmental Proceeding drawn up against Sri Kanakeswar Borgohain, Joint Director of Information and Public Relations, Assam is hereby disposed of.
