No.FSB.68/2017/252.- Consequent upon receipt of approval of the Central Government in the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food and Public Distribution, New Delhi vide No. 192(02)/2020-FC/Acs dated 9th March, 2020 read with Annexure appended therewith for payment of the provisional rates of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) for Central Pool to the Government of Assam and its Procurement Agencies during the Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2019-20 and in exercise of the powers conferred under (h) of Clause 2 read with schedule III (paragraph B) of the Assam Paddy and Rice Procurement (Levy and Licensing) Permanent Order, 1995 read with the Assam Paddy and Rice Procurement (Levy and Licensing) Amendment Permanent Order, 2000, the Governor of Assam is pleased to fix and notify the provisional rates of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) of Fair Average Quality (FAQ) together with breakup of approved admissible incidental costs of per quintal of such rice delivered to the Central Pool, during KMS-2019-20, as required under paragraph –B in Schedule III of the aforesaid Control Order and subject to the conditions as laid down and with immediate effect.

Custody and maintenance charges would be released on production of a certificate by the State Government provided these charges have been incurred by it. It will further be restricted to State Govt.'s claim.

Other Conditions

1. This costing is for procurement of paddy as per policy of usage charges for packaging of procured paddy.
2. Transportation charges / Handling Charges for transportation of paddy from mandies / purchase centre to mills and for rice from mills to State's godown will be payable from 0 km onwards as per the guidelines of transportation rates issued by Govt. of India's letter No.192(14)/2018-FC A/Cs dated 06.05.2019.
3. The payment of commission to Societies will be subject to the conditions laid vide Ministry's order no. 192(4)/2003-F.C. A/cs (Vol II). dated 26.07.2013.
4. The Custom Milled Rice would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in new 50 Kg bags only, in its local godowns upto the scale point and the stacking in the FCI godown will be done by FCI.
5. The rate/cost of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) and other elements as indicated above are provisional. The State Government should send its claims for final incidentals along with accounts audited by the auditors appointed by the Comptroller and Auditor General and documentary proof, as well as detailed justification for each item at the earliest after the end of the season and in any case not later than 12 months from the end of the financial year in which the season has ended. The States who have not submitted finalization claims within four years of commencement of marketing season, only MSP, Statutory taxes, gunny charge will be given at prevailing rates. Other incidentals shall be frozen at the rates of PCS of 2015-16 level.
6. To ensure proper utilization of funds/subsidy being released by the Government of India, the FCI may insist on requisite certificates from the State Government and its agencies for previous financial year before release of incidentals on account of statutory charges i.e. Market Fee etc. as per past practice.
7. These provisional rates / cost sheets are only for paddy / CMR procured by the State Agencies / FCI and not for any other party acting either on behalf of such State agency or the FCI. These rates would not be benchmarked to fix rate for such parties.
8. In case paddy is being kept in joint custody with the millers, relevant PPI for this purpose as issued by the Ministry from time to time, would be applicable.
