The provisions as prescribed in the Guideline regarding the powers and functions of the Development Boards/PICs and selection of Chairman/Vice-Chairman/Members and their functions and duties should be strictly adhered to.

Guidelines for Constitution and Functioning of the Sub Divisional Development Boards for SC/ST/OBC and PICs of ITDP

I. Constitution of the PIC/Development Board for SC/ST/OBC:

- (i) Each PIC/Development Board shall consist of a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 25 members
- (ii) Each PIC/Development Board shall have one Chairman and one Vice-Chairman to be appointed by the Government.
- (iii) 30% seats shall be reserved for women.
- (iv) There shall be a Selection Committee for selection of the Chairman/Vice-Chairman /Members of the PICs/Boards to be constituted as follows:
 - a) Selection Committee for selection of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of the Sub Divisional SC Development Board shall consist of:

(i) Hon'ble Minister, WPT & BC, Assam	Chairman
(ii) Sr. Most Secretary of the Deptt. or his representative not below the rank of Deputy Secretary	Member
(iii) Director, Welfare of SC, Assam	Member Secretary
 - b) Selection Committee for selection of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of the Sub Divisional OBC Development Board shall consist of:

(i) Hon'ble Minister, WPT & BC, Assam	Chairman
(ii) Sr. Most Secretary of the Deptt. or his representative not below the rank of Deputy Secretary	Member
(iii) Director, WPT & BC, Assam	Member Secretary
 - c) Selection Committee for selection of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of the PICs, ITDP and Sub Divisional ST Development Board shall consist of the following:

(i) Hon'ble Minister, WPT & BC, Assam	Chairman
(ii) Sr. Most Secretary of the Deptt. or his representative not below the rank of Deputy Secretary	Member
(iii) Director, WPT & BC, Assam	Member Secretary
- (v) The prospective candidates will have to make an application for appointment as Chairman/Vice-Chairman/Member and submit the same to the Government in the WPT & BC Department alongwith the recommendation from the

Deputy Commissioner/Minister (in-charge) concerned as per the format prescribed at **Annexure-A**.

- (vi) The Member Secretary of the Selection Committee will submit the proposal to the WPT & BC Department after it is duly approved in the Selection Committee. The proposal of the Member Secretary will *inter alia* indicate the date on which the term of the existing PIC/Dev. Board is getting over.

II. Qualification for Membership

- i) The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- ii) The candidate must belong to SC/ST/OBC community as applicable.
- iii) The age of the candidates should not be less than 25 years.
- iv) Minimum Educational qualification will be HSLC passed.
- v) He must be associated with social/community development activities for a period of at least 5 years.
- vi) He must be a permanent resident of the concerned District/Sub-Division.

III. Disqualification for Membership:

A person shall not be qualified to be a member of the PIC/Development Board for SC/ST/OBC if,

- i) He/she is not a citizen of India.
- ii) He/she is less than 25 years of age on the date of application.
- iii) He/ she does not have the minimum educational qualification.
- iv) He/she is holding any office of profit.
- v) He/she is in service of the Central or State Government, Municipality or any other authority.
- vi) He/she has been dismissed from the service of the Central or State Government or a local authority or a Co-operative Society or a Government company as defined in the Companies Act, 1956 or a corporation owned or controlled by the Central or the State Government for misconduct involving moral turpitude and five years have not elapsed from the date of such dismissal.
- vii) He/she has been adjudged by a competent court to be of unsound mind or of being an insolvent.
- viii) He/she has been convicted for any criminal offence by a competent court.
- ix) He/she has been convicted by a court of an offence involving moral turpitude punishable with imprisonment for a period of more than six months or an offence under Chapter IX A of the Indian penal Code or Chapter-III, Part III or Part VII of the Representation of Peoples Act, 1951 and five year have not elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentences. Provided that a person shall not be disqualified under this section, for reason only of his being a Member, Chairman of Vice Chairman of the Board previously.
- x) There are charges framed by a Court in a criminal case.

IV. Term of Office:

The Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of the Sub Divisional SC/ST/OBC and PICs of ITDPs shall hold their position in the board at the pleasure of the State Govt. The State Govt. may change the Chairman/Vice Chairman/Member of any board at any time. Moreover, the term of office of the board shall not exceed 3 years.

V. Conduct of Business

- a. The Chairman of the Board shall preside over the meeting. In the absence of the Chairman, the Vice-chairman will chair the meeting. In the absence of both the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman, the members present shall select, by majority vote, a member from amongst them to Chair the meeting.
- b. All decisions shall be taken on the passing of a resolution by a simple majority of the members present and voting.
- c. The quorum for transaction of any business at a meeting of the PIC/Development Board shall not be less than 1/3 of the total members of the PIC/Development Board.
- d. The decision of the PIC/Board shall be adopted by a simple majority if the members present and voting.

VI. Functions of the PICs/Boards:

- i) To select and approve list of schemes/ beneficiaries under various developmental programmes funded by the Government.
- ii) To oversee implementation of development schemes executed by various Sectoral Departments of the State Government for the benefit of relevant community.
- iii) To ensure progress of implementation of schemes and proper utilization of grants sanctioned under WPT & BC Department.
- iv) To review the SC/ST/OBC/ITDP schemes and offer suggestions on proper implementation of the same to the State Government.
- v) The PIC/Development Board shall sit atleast 3 (three) times in a financial year.
- vi) The Board shall monitor the implementation of schemes and report to the Government through PD, ITDP/SDWO.

VII. Resignation of Members:

- (i) Any Member of the PIC/Development Board including the Chairman & Vice-Chairman may resign from the office of Chairman/Vice chairman or Member as the case may be, at any time, by giving notice in writing to the Government through the Sub Divisional Welfare Officer/ Project Director, ITDP. Such resignation would be subject to acceptance by Government.
- (ii) The resignation shall take effect from such date as may be approved by the Government. In the absence of any such date being mentioned in the notice or by the approving authority it shall take effect from the date of receipt of such notice by the authority / office bearer addressed.

- (iii) In the event of any vacancy arises out of death, removal, resignation etc., such vacancy shall be filled up by the same procedure as laid down under Section-I, of these guidelines.

VIII. Member Secretary:

- (i) The Member Secretary of the PIC / Development Boards will be Project Director ITDP and the Sub Divisional Welfare Officer respectively.
- (ii) The Member Secretary shall be present and take part in the discussion of all the meetings of the PIC/ Development Board and make a statement or give explanation of facts and circumstances as may be necessary but shall not be entitled to vote.
- (iii) The Member Secretary shall be responsible for keeping the Board apprised of Government statutes / rules / guidelines / circulars / notification relevant to the functioning and activities of the PICs/ Development Boards. He / She may make a formal reference to the Government to seek guidance / clarifications on any issue pertaining to the conduct of business by the Board, if so required.
- (iv) The Member Secretary shall provide all necessary secretarial support to the PIC/Development Board for orderly conduct of their meetings, including preparation of agenda papers, issue of notices, maintaining attendance record and minutes of the meetings.

IX. Removal of Difficulties:

The Government may, by notification, amend or issue further guidelines, as necessary, for removal of difficulties in the functioning of the PICs/Board.

The Status of finalization of Annual Accounts by 22 State Public Sector Enterprises (Annexure) have been long pending with huge arrears. Further it is learnt that a number of PSEs are yet to be fully compliant to various statutes.

Role, Responsibility & Accountability of PSE, Administrative Department and DPE Assam. Finalization of accounts UpToDate and statutory compliance is the responsibility of Board of Directors/Management of respective PSEs. Omission in this regard requires the intervention of respective Administration Department. The role of DPE Assam is facilitative.

Keeping in view of the same and as decided in the Brainstorming Workshop held on 24th February, 2020, the Governor of Assam is pleased to constitute a Task Force for Mentoring and Monitoring the status of finalization of Annual Accounts of 22 State Public Sector Enterprises AND Statutory compliance in case of all PSEs expeditiously in a mission mode with the following members:

Terms of Reference of the Task Force shall be as follows :

1. To understand the challenges/ constraints being faced by Assam PSEs whose accounts are pending for more than 1 year without finalization and that of PSEs not complying with full statutory compliance as per statute.
2. To advise Assam PSEs on possible ways to overcome the long pending accounts and statutory compliance within the existing statute and Government instructions and extend all help in completing the tasks in a time bound manner.
3. Target dates: Each of the Assam PSE shall finalize all the arrear accounts as per statute, Assam Public Enterprise Policy, 2019 but not later than December 2020. Similarly in case of Statutory compliance, it shall be complied as per the statute requirement, Assam Public Enterprises Policy, 2019 but not later than Dec' 2021. And should be regular subsequently.
4. For the purpose the taskforce shall hold one to one mentoring meetings with PSEs -where in the PSEs shall make a presentation on (i) the status of accounts and (ii) statutory compliance with respect to- Challenges/ constraints, Steps involved and Time bound action plan with clarity of responsibility on each of their functionaries – CEO/ MD, Finance & Accounts Officials, Internal Auditors, Company Secretary and Statutory Auditor and BoM/BoD, and also hold regular review / monitoring meetings to help the PSEs and Administrative Departments both for the finalization of all the pending account arrears and for expediting the Statutory compliance.

The Public Enterprises Department (PED) will provide secretarial assistance to the Task Force.

No. FRM.55/2020/25.- Whereas Article 48 of the Constitution envisages protection and improvement of the Environment and safeguard of the Forests and wild life of the country.

And whereas, it is known that the pukka thread, commonly known as Chinese Manja or Chinese Dor, used for kite flying, manufactured from plastic and synthetic materials, causes injuries to people and is fatal for birds.

And whereas, such thread being non-biodegradable, damages, the environment in several ways including blockage of sewers, drainage systems, rivers, streams, reservoirs and suffocates animals who may consume the same.

And whereas, such thread is a conductor of electricity, it often results in flash-overs on the power lines and sub-stations causes power interruptions, straining and damaging of electrical assets, accidents, injuries and loss of life.

And whereas, certain species of birds are getting rare or extinct and it is imperative to protect them from similarly resulting injuries.

And whereas, in compliance of the order of the Learned National Green Tribunal in Original Application No. 384 of 2016 khalid Ashraf-Vs- Union of India & Others, the State Government upon carefully examining the matter is of the opinion that the use of such synthetic thread be banned in the interest of safety and conservation of wildlife.

And whereas, the Central Government vide its notification No. 1 (38)/86.PI dtd. 10th February, 1988 has delegated the powers vested in it under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (No. 29 of 1986) to the Government of the State of Assam.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers converted by section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (No. 29 of 1986) read with sub-rule (5) of Rule (4) of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, in order to address the adverse effects of the use of such synthetic thread general safety and biodiversity and to promote use of eco-friendly alternative to such thread. The State Government hereby, completely prohibits, the sale, production, storage, supply and use of nylon synthetic or any other such thread coated with finely crushed glass metal or any other sharp objects including thread commonly known as Chinese Manja or Chinese dor in the State of Assam.

The Violation of the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (No. 29 of 1986) or the rules made there under shall be punishable under Section 15 of the said Act, which includes imprisonment for a term which may extend to five years with fine which may extend to one lakh rupees or with both.

Revised Guidelines for construction of Gaon Panchayat Building, Repairing of dilapidated Gaon Panchayat Building and Setting up of Co-located Common Service Centre under RGSA.

Background & Objectives: Panchayati Raj Institutions are democratic local government institutions working towards good governance, social inclusion, gender equality and economic development. The 73rd Amendment of the Constitution has mandated the responsibility of local planning and developmental activities to the panchayats and envisioned a people led development at the grass root level. Panchayati Raj system was mandated the twin objectives of ensuring economic development and social justice for the people living in the rural areas. Apart from the mandated programmes, the panchayats are increasingly being assigned functions under different programmes of the Central and State Government. The RGSA has given special thrust to strengthen the capacities of institutions for rural local governance to become more responsive towards local development need, prepare participatory plans, leveraging technology and efficiently utilize available resources for realizing sustainable solutions to local problems linked to SDG.

With the above objectives, strengthening of Gaon Panchayat infrastructure is very essential to discharge the proper functioning of the grass root level governance. In order to strengthen the infrastructure at Gaon Panchayat, it is proposed to construct building with the funding of MoPR, Gol under RGSA for providing the facilities as well as open areas are used effectively for carrying out the functions of the Gaon Panchayats:

- Provision of work space and personnel.
- Provision for sitting of public.
- Provision for meeting of Gram Sabhas.
- Multifunctional rooms.
- Supporting ICT infrastructure for MIS.
- Construction of toilets with separate toilets for women.
- Electricity connection and water supply.
- Providing barrier free access for persons with disabilities.
- Information wall.

Target: As per the approved RGSA Action Plan 2018 – 19 and 2019 – 20, the Government of India has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 660.00 lakhs for construction of 20 + 13 new Gaon Panchayat Building @ Rs. 20.00 lakhs and for repairing of existing dilapidated GP building, the Ministry has earmarked an amount of Rs. 180.00 lakhs @ Rs. 4.00 lakhs per GP and also allocated an amount of Rs. 3.00 crores @ Rs. 4.00 lakhs for construction of additional building for setting up of co-located Common Service Centre. The guidelines will be effective for implementation of the schemes for consecutive years as per the allocation of fund from the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Government of India under the head.

Plan and estimate: The concerned Gaon Panchayat through Zilla Parishad / Development Block will prepare the plan and estimates as per their requirement along with Technical Sanction and submit to the institute for obtaining approval of government.

Financial allocation: The Government of India, Ministry of Panchayati Raj has been providing the financial support under RGSA for construction of new GP building @ Rs. 20.00 lakhs per building, Rs. 4.00 lakhs for repairing of dilapidated GP building and also to setting up of Common Service Centre in the GP offices @ Rs. 4.00 lakhs per unit. Under the approved plan of 2018 – 19 and 2019 – 20, the Ministry of Panchayati Raj has sanctioned and released the fund for the following activities:

Selection of Gaon Panchayat Offices for construction of new building: Under the SOPD, the state government has been providing financial support for construction of GP building @ Rs. 40.00 lakhs per GP building which is doubled the amount sanctioned under RGSA. Under the RGSA implementation framework, there is a provision to converge the construction works with other programmes like MGNREGA etc. Considering this, it has been proposed to construct the GP building under RGSA in the following categories:

- Gaon Panchayat offices who have building in exist without having adequate space as incorporated in the construction of GP building @ Rs. 40.00 lakhs per GP under SOPD, will be selected to construct the additional building with office rooms, meeting hall, public space, toilet etc.
- Gaon Panchayat office who have Rajiv Gandhi Sewa Kendra constructed under MGNREGA with inadequate provision for office accommodation as incorporated in construction of Gaon Panchayat building under SOPD @ Rs. 40.00 lakhs unit cost.

Selection of Gaon Panchayat offices for repairing of existing dilapidated building: The list to be submitted by the Zilla Parishads will be scrutinized at state level by constituting a committee to be notified by the department for selection of GPs which needs urgent repairing and will obtain approval of Government in Panchayat & Rural Development Department for implementation.

Selection of Gaon Panchayat offices for setting up of Co-located Common Service Centres: As per framework of implementation of RGSA, there is a provision to set up common service centre in the GP offices by constructing an additional building. The GPs will be selected based on the list to be submitted by the Zilla Parishads by a committee to be constituted by the government and will obtain approval of Government in Panchayat & Rural Development Department for implementation.

Committee for selection of GP for construction of building, repairing and setting up of CSC and also the selection procedure: A state level committee will be constituted by government for selection of GPs to be taken up for construction of new building, repairing, setting up of CSC. The members of the committee as follows:

1. Commissioner, P & RD, Govt. of Assam –Chairman.
2. Director, SIPRD, Assam – Member Secretary.
3. Jt. Director (RGSA), O/o the CPRD – Member.
4. Sr. Technical Consultant, SIPRD, Assam – Member.
5. Sr. Finance & Accounts Officer, SIPRD, Assam – Member.

- The committee is the competent authority to select the GPs based on the list to be submitted by the Zilla Parishad to be constructed under the schemes considering the needs of facilities to be provided to Gaon Panchayat office as stated in the objectives of this guidelines.
- The committee shall review the present status of the GPs to be submitted by the ZPs and select the GP offices.
- After finalizing the list the committee will recommend the name of the GPs to be taken up for construction of new building, repairing, setting up of CSC etc. to the institute.
- The institute on being recommended by the committee will subsequently submit the list to the government for obtaining approval.

Committee for execution, monitoring and evaluation: A district level committee will be constituted by the government for proper execution, monitoring and evaluation of the construction works. The committee will supervise and monitor the construction works to be taken up in their respective district. The members of the committee will be as follows:

1. Chairperson of Zilla Parishad	Chairman.
2. Chief Executive Officer	Member Secretary.
3. Concerned Block Development Officer	Member.
4. Local MLA	Member.
5. President of the concerned Gaon Panchayat	Member.
6. Secretary of concerned GP	Member.
7. Executive Engineer of Zilla Parishad	Technical Member.

Implementation strategy:

- The State Institute of Rural Development will be the nodal agency to implement the scheme.
- The Zilla Parishad will prepare the plan and estimates as per their local requirement and obtain Technical Sanction from the competent authority.
- The Zilla Parishad will subsequently submit the plan and estimates along with Technical Sanction to the institute for obtaining approval from the government.
- The Zilla Parishads will float the tenders / e-tenders for selection of firms to execute the works as per existing rules of government for selection of contractors. Without going for separate tender for each GP building, the Zilla Parishads will float tender / e-tender in a package manner for the concerned district.
- The tender committee as notified by the Zilla Parishads will be entrusted the responsibility to evaluate the tenders to be submitted by the tenderers.
- The Zilla Parishad after finalizing the firms to be recommended by the tender committee through tender process will communicate the name of the firm to the SIPRD.
- The Zilla Parishad will execute the required agreement and also issue formal work orders to the selected firm for execution of works.
- If any dispute arises in case of rate submitted by tenderers are found not workable, the tendering authority may ask the tenderer to submit the analysis of offered rate. In such case, if the lowest rate is excepted, the tendering authority may ask the tenderer to submit 10% of the allotted work value as security deposit. Defect liability period for the construction works is considered as 2 years from the date of completion of the work in all respect. An undertaking should be submitted by the tenderers in proper format.

Mode of payment: The SIPRD will release the fund to the concerned Zilla Parishad in a phase manner based on the progress report of Zilla Parishad.

Maintenance of records:

- The SIPRD will keep all the records relating to selection of GP offices, minutes of the meeting of the selection committee, tender committee, records relating to tenders etc.
- The Zilla Parishad will maintain all the records relating to minutes of the meeting of district level committee, approval and construction works, Bill, vouchers etc. will be preserved at the Zilla Parishad for audit purpose.

Submission of utilization certificate: The CEO, Zilla Parishad will monitor the entire process of construction works and submit the report to the institute for onward submission to the government. The Executive Engineer of concerned Zilla Parishad or where the Zilla Parishad does not have Executive Engineer may entrust the responsibility to the Executive Engineer, PWD (Building) for proper technical monitoring of the work.

After making final payment to the contractor, the CEO, Zilla Parishad will submit the Utilisation Certificate in prescribed proforma along with photographs of the construction works, along with other required report from the Executive Engineer.

Time line for completion of work:

- After receiving the formal communication for selection of contractor from the SIPRD, the Zilla Parishad concern will issue formal work order within 7 days.
- The construction works should be completed within 4 (four) months on receipt of formal work order by the contractor.
- Soon after completion of construction works, the Zilla Parishad will release the final payment after obtaining report from the Executive Engineer.

Let. No. PG. 22/70/P-II/1, dated Shillong, the 2nd June, 1970 from the Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam to all Administrative Departments, all Head of Departments, All Deputy Commissioners and Subdivisional Officers.

SUBJECT :- Timely publication of Government Notifications and other important matters in the weekly Official Gazette.

I am directed to say that it has come to the notice of Government that important notification having bearing on statutes and matters of immediate public interest are sometimes published in the Official Gazette on date much later than prescribed. Government have decided, therefore, to introduce the following system with immediate effect, which must be strictly adhered to in sending notice to the Assam Government Press for publication in the official Gazette.

1. In the first instance, it has to be noted that the printing of the weekly Gazette must be completed by the end of every Tuesday so that it may be duly published on every Wednesday.

2. Every notification and every other matter which is required to be printed and published in a particular issue of the Official Gazette must, therefore, reach the Director, Assam Government Press on the Monday of the week preceding the week in which it is required to be published. If this is not done it is infructuous requesting the Director, Assam Government Press to publish such notification or other matter in the next issue of the Gazette, the expression usually inserted in all endorsements made to the Director.

3. Wherever it is necessary to print and publish a notification on a specified date (excluding such Notification or communicate as are to be published in Gazette extraordinary) clear instruction of that effect must be given to the Director, Assam Government Press, both on the body of such notification within the indication at the top in the red ink and is a separate covering.

4. To achieve the objective in papers 2 and 3, it is essential that proper discretion should be exercised by the concerned officers in the Department or office and all matters for publication in the Gazette should scrutinised and sent to the Press after careful application.

5. As for publication of any matters in a Gazette, Extraordinary, the existing procedure whereby the prior approval of the General Administration Department is to be obtained will continue.

I am to request you to acknowledge the receipt of this letter and confirmed that the instructions have been duly voted. If you have suggestion on this behalf they may please be communicated.
