No. CAD.204/2021/10.- The Governor of Assam is pleased to approve the Guidelines in connection with One Time Financial Assistance to Priests and Namghorias under the Cultural Affairs Department as follows:

Assam is a land which boasts of a glorious cultural heritage. It also possesses places of religious and historical importance rich in diverse tradition and culture including various Temples and Namghors.

Temple: A Building devoted to the worship of a God or Goddess, reserved for spiritual rituals and activities such as prayer and sacrifice. Offerings of some sort are made to the deity, and other rituals enacted, and a special group maintain and operate the temple.

Namghor: "Namghors", literally prayer house, are places for congregational worship associated with the Ekasarana Vaishnavite religion of Assam. "Naam" means prayer and "Ghar" means house which was an unique creation of Srimanta Sankardeva. Namghors are not only places of worship, but are also centres of learning, institutions for imparting education, community halls where people gather to discuss their social problems, training centres for Arts and Crafts and above all centres of unity for the society. Some of the officials known to be associated with the Namghor are Medhi, Bujandar, Bayan, Namgharia, Bilonia etc.

BACKGROUND:

The Priests or the *Pujaris* are authorized to perform religious duties in temples regularly. Most of these institutions are running from public contributions but due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the temples are closed for a long period of time or opened with limited admission of devotees and the Priests associated with them have suffered financially.

Similarly, the livelihoods of the people associated with Namghors are severely affected due to the closure for a long period of time due to the Covid-19 outbreak.

So, to give relief to this section of people, the Govt. of Assam in the Cabinet dated 20th August, 2021 has decided to provide One Time Financial Assistance @ Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) only as one time grant to the Priests of Devalaya, Devasthans and "Than" and Namghorias of Namghor and Sattra Namghor.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a) The applicant must be a permanent resident of Assam.
- b) The Minimum age of the applicant as on 01.01.2021 should not be less than 40 years.
- c) For experience the applicant must be serving in the Temple/ Namghor in the capacity of the Priest/Namghoria for more than 5 (five) years or above which should be certified by the President/Secretary of the Managing Committee/ Governing Body of particular institution.
- d) Priests and Namghorias would have to be regularly performing religious duties in Temples and Namghars for at least a period of 5(five) years and a certificate from the Management Committee to the effect stating that the concerned Priest or Namghoria has been drawing monthly honorarium should be submitted.
- e) The Temple/ Naamghor should be at least 50 years old.
- f) Annual Income of the applicant should be less than Rs. 3.00 Lakh from all sources.
- g) Central Government Pensioners, State Government Pensioners are not eligible for this scheme.
- h) Only a single entry per applicant is allowed.
- i) The applicant must have his/her own Bank Account. The name of the applicant should be same as the name of the Account holder in the Bank passbook or else the application will not be considered for selection. Bank Details should be submitted correctly with new IFSC code (wherever applicable).

Documents/ Certificates Needed to be Uploaded during the Application Process:

- a) One Passport size photograph of the applicant has to be uploaded in the online Portal.
- b) For age proof any of the relevant documents such as Voter ID, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, Driving License, Birth Certificate, HSLC Admit Card etc. must be uploaded.
- c) Experience Certificate (Not less than 5 years) (As stated in the Eligibility Criteria Point No. 3) from particular institution (Temple/ Namghor) duly signed by President/Secretary of the Managing Committee/ Governing Body of particular institution on behalf of which the applicant is applying must be uploaded.
- d) For Income a self certified written document has to be uploaded. The Template for the document will be provided in the Online Portal itself.
- e) Photographs of the applicant performing respective rituals at the premises of the institution duly certified by President/Secretary of the Managing Committee/ Governing Body must be uploaded.
- f) The Applicant must upload a clear photocopy of the first page of the Bank passbook.

Plan of Implementation:

The applicant will have to apply online. Documents as mentioned above will have to be uploaded in the designated portal which will be notified in due course. The total list of applicants will be uploaded in the designated portal for Public viewing and any grievances related to the applicants will be resolved. There will be a Departmental Committee for selection of the Beneficiaries. After the selection abiding to all financial rules, the grant will be debited to their respective account by DBT (Direct Beneficiary Transfer). Remuneration of Rs. 15,000/- as one time Grants in Aid will be provided to the selected Priest and Namghorias.
