NOTIFICATION

The 28th November, 2023

eCF No. 303428/30. In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to the Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Elementary Education (Provincialisation) Rules, 1977, hereinafter referred to as Principal Rules, namely:-

Short title and Commencement

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Assam Elementary Education (Provincialisation) (Amendment) Rules, 2023.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Substitution of Schedule-I

2. In the Principal Rules, for the existing Schedule-I, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

Schedule-I

[See Rule 3(vi) (a)]

- 1. Selection of Teacher for Lower Primary School and for teaching in Class-I to Class-V, shall be made as per the following proportions:-
 - (a) 5% of the marks secured in Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary or equivalent Examinations.
 - (b) 5% of the marks secured in Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed) or Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed) examination or Diploma in Education (Special Education).
 - (c) 85% of the marks secured in Teachers' Eligibility Test for Lower Primary schools.

(d)

(i) NCC Certificates (5 marks for "C" Certificate and 3 marks for "B" Certificate)

Or

(ii) 5 marks for participation/ achievement in recognised sports at National Level or beyond representing Assam.

Or

- (iii) 5 marks for participation/ achievement in recognised Fine Arts and Cultural activities representing State at National Level or beyond (organized by recognised institutions).
- 3. Selection of Teacher in Upper Primary School and for teaching in Class-VI to Class-VIII shall be made as per the following proportions:-
 - (a) 5% of the marks secured in Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary or equivalent Examinations.
 - (b) 5% of the marks secured in Graduation examination. In case of candidates having Major in any subject, the marks secured in the Major subject shall be taken into consideration.
 - (c) 5% of the marks secured in Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) or Bachelor Of Education (B.Ed.) examination or D. Ed. (Special Education) or B.Ed.(Special Education).
 - (d) 80% of the marks secured in Teachers' Eligibility Test for Upper Primary schools.

(e)

(i) NCC Certificates (5 marks for "C" Certificate and 3 marks for "B" Certificate)

Or

(ii) 5 marks for participation/ achievement in recognised sports at National Level or beyond representing Assam.

Or

(iii) 5 marks for participation/ achievement in recognised Fine Arts and Cultural activities representing State at National Level or beyond (organized by recognised institutions).
