No.346929/35.- The Governor of Assam is pleased to constitute a Land Governance Commission consisting of the following members to examine the requirement of amendment, revision etc. of Land and Revenue State Acts and Regulations, various rules made thereunder, consider judicial pronouncements, make suggestions, recommendations for matters incidental thereto.

The terms of reference of the Commission shall be as follows:

1. The Commission will consider the existing Land and Revenue related statutes covering the themes – land rights recognition, communal and forest land, urban land, public land management and land acquisition, public land disposal, land records and cadastre, land valuation and taxation, land dispute resolution and review of institutional arrangements and policies.
2. The Commission will evolve a draft Assam Land Governance Bill which will inter alia include the **conclusive land titling framework** with adequate feedback from various stakeholders of land governance ecosystem.
3. The Commission will examine the institutional capacity of the land governance ecosystem, necessities for strengthening towards implementing a futuristic land governance framework and make suitable recommendations.

The Commission will submit its recommendation within 6 (six) months from the date of assumption of office. The Commission will be assisted by the Land Governance Risk Reduction Unit in undertaking the required assessment, revisions and framing its recommendations.
