## NOTIFICATION

The 29th December, 2020

**No.ATE.140/2015/38.**-In exercise of Power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Technical Education Service Rules, 1981, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, namely :-

| Short title and commencement | 1. (1) These rules may be called the Assam Technical Education Service (Amendment) Rules, 2020<br>(2) They shall come in to force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.   |
| Amendment of rule 2          | 2. In the principal Rules, in rule 2, after clause (k), the following new clause (1) shall be inserted, namely :-<br>“(1) CAS means Career Advancement Scheme.”   |
| Amendment of rule 3          | 3. In the principal Rules, in rule 3, -<br>(i) In sub-rule (1),-<br>(a) in clauses (a), for sub-clauses (iv), (v), (vii) and (viii) the following shall be substituted, namely :-<br>“(iv) Associate Professor, Engineering College;<br>(v) Joint Director/Principal, Polytechnic / Controller of Examination / Training and Placement Officer; |

(vii) Head of Department, Polytechnic / Deputy Controller of Examination;

(viii) Assistant Professor, Engineering College.”

(b) in clause (b), for sub-clause (i), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“(i) Lecturer, Polytechnic/ Assistant Controller of Examination.”

(ii) after sub-clause (ii), the following new sub-clause (iii) shall be inserted, namely :-

“(iii) Librarian of Engineering College / Librarian of Polytechnic.”

(iii) in sub-rule (3);-

(a) for clause (a) and (b), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“(a) The cadres of Professor, Associate Professor, Head of Department, Polytechnic and Assistant Professor of Engineering College as well as Lecturer of Polytechnic shall have subject wise branches and each such branch shall be deemed to constitute a separate cadre.

(b) The post of Workshop Superintendent in Engineering College shall belong to Mechanical Branch.”

(b) after the clause (b), the following new clause (c), shall be inserted, namely :-

“(c) The post of Workshop Superintendent in Polytechnic and the post of Superintendent, Junior Technical School shall belong to Automobile Engineering / Civil Engineering/ Chemical Engineering / Computer Science Engineering / Electrical Engineering / Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering / Instrumentation Engineering / Mechanical Engineering with the qualification and experience as prescribed in Schedule – II.”

Amendment of rule 5 4. In the principal Rules, in rule 5, for clauses (3), (4), (5), (6) and (7) the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“(3) In the cadres of Professor Engineering College, Associate Professor Engineering College, Principal, Polytechnic / Joint Director / Controller of Examination / Training and Placement Officer / Head of Department, Polytechnic/ Deputy Controller of Examination, Workshop Superintendent Polytechnic/ Superintendent Junior Technical School, -

By promotion in accordance with rules 11, 12 and 13 against the entire strength of the categories of posts.

(4) In the cadres of Lecturer, Polytechnic, -

- (a) By promotion in accordance with rules 11, 13 and 14 and,
- (b) By direct recruitment in accordance with rules 6(1) and 18.
- (c) The percentage of the strength of each of the cadres to be filled by promotion and by direct recruitment shall be as herein below :-

Name of cadre	Shares of direct requirement and promotion in the cadre	
Lecturer, Polytechnic	33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % of total cadre strength	66 $\frac{2}{3}$ % of total cadre strength

(5) In the cadre of Assistant Professor, Engineering College, Workshop Superintendent, Engineering College / Assistant Controller of Examination / Librarian, Engineering College / Polytechnic, -

By direct recruitment in accordance with rules 6(1) and 18

(6) Subject to suitability as may be decided by the Appointing Authority and also subject to possessing the requisite qualification and experience as set forth in Schedule – II, the incumbents of the different categories of posts mentioned in the cadre of :-

- (a) Joint Director/ Controller of Examination / Training and Placement Officer / Principal, Polytechnic
- (b) Head of the Department Polytechnics / Deputy Controller of Examination
- (c) Lecturer, Polytechnics/ Assistant Controller of Examination
- (d) Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnics/ Superintendent Junior Technical School shall be interchangeable from one category to other within the cadre.

(7) In case sufficient number of candidates are not available for filling all the vacancies in the cadres of Assistant Professor, Engineering College and Lecturer, Polytechnic in a particular year or years, the Appointing Authority may fill such residual vacancies by temporary transfer of deputation of suitable qualified officers of other Department of the Government / Government Undertakings.”

- Amendment of rule 7 5. In the principal rules, in rule 7, in the table, for paragraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) the following shall be substitute, namely :-

- Amendment of rule 11 6. In the principal Rules, in rule 11 in sub-rule (3), after clause (c), the following new clause (4) shall be inserted, namely :-

“(4) Recruitment by promotion as Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic / Superintendent Junior Technical School – Appointment by promotion in the cadre of Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic / Superintendent Junior Technical School, shall be made in the manner prescribed hereinafter, -

- (a) Subject to suitability as may be decided by the Board and by the appointing authority in consultation with the Commission, an officer belonging to the cadres of Senior Instructor, Foreman and Supervising Instructor in the Assam Technical Education (Junior) Service and possessing the qualifications as set forth herein below shall be promoted to the cadre of Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic/ Superintendent Junior Technical School, in the manner provided in rules 13 and 14.
- (b) Entire strength of the cadre of Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic/ Superintendent Junior Technical School shall be filled by promotion subject to availability of suitable candidates

provided that any shortfall of this reservation due to non-availability of adequate number of suitable candidates in a particular year or years shall be carried forward to the subsequent year (s).

(c) A member of the cadres of Senior Instructor, Forman and Supervising Instructor in the Assam Technical Education (Junior) Service be eligible for promotion as Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic/ Superintendent Junior Technical School as per the qualification and experience as prescribed for the Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic/ Superintendent Junior Technical School in Schedule – II.”

(d)

Amendment of rule 12 7. In the Principal Rules, the existing 12 will be substituted by the following:-

“(1) In the cadres of Professor Engineering College, Associate Professor, Engineering College, Principal, Polytechnic/ Joint Director/ Controller of Examination/Training & Placement Officer/ HOD, Polytechnic/ Deputy Controller of Examination of the service to the extent as specified in sub-rules (3) and (4) (c) of Rule 5 shall be filled by promotion in the manner prescribed herein below-

Provided that the Governor may, for good and sufficient reasons, fill any of the posts for specialised investigation, design and research work temporarily on deputation from outside the service if it is satisfied that there is no suitable officer in the service available for filling the vacancy.”

(2) In case of specialisation of a member of the service posted in connection with the specialised subject, shall be retained in the same specialised works, on his promotion in the normal course, by creation of a higher post in the cadre to which he is so promoted, keeping the lower post held by him in abeyance, if the Government considers that such an officer cannot be withdrawn from the specialised works without serious dislocation due to non-availability of any other officer of the lower cadre in the service to perform the specified works.

“(3) Subject of suitability as may be decided by the Board and by the Appointing Authority as set forth in Rule 13 and by the Commission wherever such consultation with the Commission is necessary under Rule 14 and also subject possessing qualifications and experience as prescribed hereinafter, an officer shall be eligible for promotion from one cadre to another of the service in manner provide below : -

(i) Associate Professor to Professor, Engineering College.

(ii) Head of Department, Polytechnic/Deputy Controller of Examination to Principal Polytechnics / Joint Director / Controller of Examination/ Training & Placement Officer.

(iii) Assistant Professor, Engineering College to Associate Professor, Engineering College.

(iv) Lecturer, Polytechnic to Head of Department, Polytechnic.”

Amendment of rule 15 8. In the principal Rules, in rule 15, in sub-rule (1), after clause (iv), the following new clause shall be inserted, namely :-

“(v) Joint Secretary, Department of Welfare and Plain Tribes and Backward Classes.”

Amendment of Schedule – I 9. In the principal Rules, for the Schedule-I, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

Amendment of Schedule -II 10. In the principal Rules, in Schedule-II.-  
(i) for paragraph 8, the following shall be substitute, namely :-  
“8, Workshop Superintendent, Polytechnic : 1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with 8 years workshop experience.

Or

1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) Diploma in Automobile Engineering / Civil Engineering / Chemical Engineering / Computer Science Engineering / Electrical Engineering / Electronics and telecommunication Engineering / Instrumentation Engineering with 10 years workshop experience.

Or

Diploma 1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) and Bachelor degree in Automobile Engineering / Civil Engineering / Chemical Engineering / Computer Science Engineering / Electrical Engineering / Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering / Instrumentation Engineering / Mechanical Engineering with 5 years experience in respective subject.”

(ii) for paragraph 11, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“11. Superintendent, Junior Technical School : 1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with 8years workshop experience.

Or

1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) Diploma in Automobile Engineering / Civil Engineering / Chemical engineering / Computer Science Engineering / Electrical Engineering / Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering / Instrumentation Engineering with 10 years workshop experience.

Or

Diploma 1<sup>st</sup> Class (60%) and Bachelor Degree in Automobile Engineering / Civil Engineering / Chemical Engineering / Computer Science Engineering / Electrical Engineering / Electronics and telecommunication Engineering / Instrumentation Engineering / Mechanical Engineering with 5 years experience in respective subject.
