NOTIFICATION

No.MER.354019/259.-In view of commencement of Mukhya Mantri Lok Sevak Arogya Yojana (MMLSAY)- Medical reimbursement of Government employees, Government pensioners and their dependents through an online IT portal, an Advisory Board is hereby constituted for smooth implementation of the Scheme.

The composition of the Advisory Board will be as follows:

1. Chairman: Minister, Medical Education & Research, Government of Assam
2. Member Secretary: Chief Executive Officer, Atal Amrit Abhiyan Society
3. Members:
 - a. One member each from various service associations, nominations for which will be given by different Government Departments.
 - b. Representative of the Finance Department in the Admissibility Board
 - c. Senior Financial Advisor MMLSAY, Atal Amrit Abhiyan Society.
 - d. Any other Member nominated by Minister, Medical Education & Research Department.

The Terms of Reference of the Board will be as follows:

1. The Advisory Board will have at least one sitting in a year.
2. The Advisory Board will decide on the monthly premium to be contributed by employees every year based on the total expenditure against the total contribution amount.
3. The Advisory Board will recommend the amount to be borne by the State or recommend any adjustment with the monthly premium contribution in the next financial year based on the total contribution against the total reimbursement expenditure.

4. The Advisory Board will decide on inclusion/ exclusion of any medical procedure under MMLSAY after analysing the justifications for the same.
5. The Advisory Board may recommend any change/ modification in the operational guidelines of MMLSAY for smooth functioning of the same.
6. The Advisory Board may recommend any change/ modification in the online IT portal for easy usage of the same.
7. The Advisory Board will take necessary steps to act in any proven fraud/ malpractice in case of any reimbursement claim.
8. All decisions taken by the Advisory Board will need to be approved by the Chairman of the Board.
