NOTIFICATION

No.FEB.97/2013/21.- In pursuance of Clause 3 of Article 166 of the Constitution of India and all powers enabling in this behalf, the Governor of Assam is pleased to direct that the following specific powers shall be delegated to the Public Works Department temporarily (till 31st March, 2020) under Schedule -III of the Delegation of Financial Power Rules 1999 (As amended up to date).
