NOTIFICATION

e-File No. 197726/20.- The Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to announce the holding of Common Entrance Test (CEE) for admission into B.Sc Nursing (both Govt. and Private) institutes in order to enhance quality of Nursing Education in the State of Assam from session 2022 onwards. The following modalities to be followed for the same:-

- 1. Eligibility criteria of candidates to appear the Common Entrance Exam: Candidate must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Science or Equivalent Examination from recognized Board/ Council/ University with English as one of the subjects and securing at least 50% marks aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology for General Category candidates, 45% for PWD candidates and 40% marks for the candidates belonging to SC/ST(P)/ST(H) category without grace marks.
- 2. The minimum qualifying criteria/cut off score in the Entrance Examination of B.Sc Nursing course is to be as follows:

a) General (UR/EWS) - 50 %.

b) SC/ST/OBC - 40%.

c) UR-PWD - 45%.

 - 3. If seats remain vacant, the minimum percentage will be re-assessed before 2nd Counselling.
 - 4. 25% in B.Sc Nursing seats to be kept reserved under Management Quota for private institutions provided the candidate secures cut off score.
 - 5. The entrance test shall be conducted by Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences (SSUHS).
