No. E-233475/272.- In exercise of the powers conferred as per Clause 1 (3) (d) & (g) of the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution of India, and after due consideration of the Interim Report submitted by the Commission of Alteration of the Areas included under Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR) [*constituted vide Government Notification no. TAD/BC/227/2020/54 dated 29.09.2020*], the Governor of Assam is pleased accord approval to transfer of 11 villages from Darrang District to Udalguri District and transfer of 10 villages from Nalbari District to Tamulpur District as detailed below. Consequently, all these 21 villages will form part of Bodoland Territorial Region.

This order comes into force with immediate effect.
