No. ELE 69/2014/141.- The Notification No. ELE 69/2014/136, dated 22nd February, 2024 is hereby published for general information.

NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the 22nd February 2024

No. ELE.69/2014/136.- In pursuance of the Provisions of Section 166 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Govt. of Assam hereby delegates the powers conferred upon it by Provisions of Sections 160, 161, 162, 163, 164 and 165 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 to the District Commissioners & Sub-Divisional Officers as District Election Officers of the State of Assam, to requisition any premises, vehicles etc. in connection with the conduct of ensuing General Election to Lok Sabha, 2024 for the purpose as specified below:

- a) Any premises needed or likely to be needed for the purpose of being used as Polling Station or for the storage of Electronic Voting Machines after a poll has been taken, or
- b) Any vehicle, vessel or animal needed or is likely to be needed for the purpose of transport of Electronic Voting Machines to or from any polling station, or transport of members of police force for maintaining order during the conduct of such elections or transport of any officer or other person for performance of any duties in connection with such elections.

In issuing such order for requisition, the District Commissioners & Sub-Divisional Officers as District Election Officers of the State of Assam will keep in mind the findings of the Division Bench of the Gauhati High Court in Civil Rule No. 523/83-Hemanta Kumar Sarma-Vs-State of Assam and others, covered under the provision of Assam Requisition and Control of Vehicles Act, 1968, both in letter and spirit.
