No. GLR.65/2019/49.-In pursuance to the State Reform Action Points, 2020 recommended by Department for Promotion of Industrial and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India and in exercise of the powers conferred under subsection 3 of Section 34 of the Boiler Act, 1923 read with Rule 3B of Indian Boiler Regulation, 1950, Governor of Assam is pleased to introduce a provision for Third Party Certification for Boilers authorizing Boiler Operation Engineer (BOE) during use of Boilers subject to maintaining the following conditions, namely :-

- 1) The Authorised Boiler Operation Engineer (BOE) must possess the following qualification-
 - a) A degree in Mechanical/ Production/ Power Plant/ Metallurgical Engineering from a recognized Institution.
- 2) His age must be 60 years or below and shall be a regular employee of a recognised Inspecting Authority under Central Boiler Board, Government of India notified by the state government for third party certification earlier vide Notification No. GLR.71/2016/B/20, dated 16th October, 2016.
- 3) This Authorization shall be valid in respect of boilers after compliance of all three conditions as prescribed under Regulation 3B of the Indian Boiler (Amendment) Regulations, 2015 subject to the option of the boiler owner. Inspection certification and other related activities in respect of all other boilers shall be carried forward by the inspectorate as usual and their functioning shall not be affected.
- 4) This shall be in force specific to an individual industry at the option of the Boiler owner only. The BOE must immediately intimate Chief Inspector of Boiler or his representative in respective area before start of activities. The suitability of Boiler for initiating his activities shall be decided by the Chief inspector of boilers.
- 5) The Boiler owner and Authorised BOE both are to strictly comply to all safety provisions as laid under Boilers Act, 1923 and Indian Boiler Regulation, 1950 and to ensure safety of life, limbs and Industrial properties.
- 6) The authorized Boiler Operation Engineer (BOE) must strictly comply of all timelines stipulated under Indian Boiler Regulation, 1950 and the time lines stipulated through State Government notification.
- 7) This authorisation is not applicable for inspection and certification during Registration as well as during Repair of a Boiler.
- 8) All functions / Activities of the Authorised Boiler Operation Engineer (BOE) shall be monitored time to time by the representative of the Chief Inspector of Boilers in the respective area for appropriate compliances of Rules to ensure safety.
- 9) Owner shall be liable to be penalised as per provision of the Boiler Act, 1923 for any non compliances.
- 10) Any violation made by the Authorised Boiler Operation Engineer (BOE) may be liable to be fined with an amount of a maximum of rupees fifty thousand or cancellation of his Authorisation or both.
- 11) In the event of an accident during the currency of the certificate by the Authorised BOE, the same has to be intimated to the Chief Inspector of Boilers, Assam for his necessary course of action as per

provisions of the Boiler Act. All emergency and accident cases shall be taken care of by this Inspectorate only as per Rule.

12) A provision of online payment and application shall be formulated with NIC, in respect of any boiler inspected and certified by the authorised BOE and the same may be integrated with the current online system of this Inspectorate. The onus of digitized payment, online process of application and inspection lie with the authorised BOE.

13) The process of application and certification may be done offline at the option of the boiler owner. In this case, the owner has to send the copy of Challan to this Inspectorate along with a copy of certificate for record. The format of the certificate shall have to be approved by the Chief Inspector of Boilers. The same offline procedure must also apply till the process of online integration is not completed.

14) The State Government may at any time modify or withdraw the Notification.

Apparently, the above mentioned subject does not involve amendment in any related Rules, Acts. If it is observed in future that amendment of any Acts or Rules is required to give effect to the notification, it will be done accordingly. The notification will be modified/ cancelled accordingly.

The Notification will come into immediate effect.
